CITY OF PROSPECT ORDINANCE NO. 655, SERIES 2025

AN ORDINANCE ENACTING AND ADOPTING THE 2024 SUPPLEMENT TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF PROSPECT

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation of Cincinnati, Ohio has completed the 2024 Supplement to the Code of Ordinances of the City of Prospect, which supplement contains all ordinances of a general nature enacted since the prior supplement to the Code of Ordinances of this municipality; and

WHEREAS, American Legal Publishing Corporation has recommended the revision or addition of certain sections of the Code of Ordinances which are based on or make references to sections of the Kentucky Revised Statutes; and
