- **Trash, Recycling, and Yard Waste Pickup:** The city provides weekly trash pickup at the backdoor, weekly yard waste pickup at the curb, and bi-weekly recycling pickup at the curb. Contact City Hall if you do not have a recycling cart. Among the enclosures is a calendar that identifies the dates for recycling pickup.
